Dear Madam Speaker,


On behalf of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe, I am pleased to forward to you the Tbilisi Declaration adopted on July 5, 2016 at the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Session. Parliamentarians from 53 participating States attended the Annual Session and participated in thorough discussions and debates on topical OSCE-related issues. Parliamentarians focused their work on the central theme of *"25 Years of Parliamentary Co-operation: Building Trust Through Dialogue."*

In addition to the Tbilisi Declaration, I include herein the other resolutions adopted by the Assembly in Tbilisi, which cover topics such as "The Security Challenges of Migration," "Law Enforcement Co-ordination to Prevent Child Sexual Exploitation and Trafficking by Known Sex Offenders," and "The Rights of Refugees."

At the Annual Session in Tbilisi, the Assembly elected a new President, H. E. Ms. Christine Muttonen of Austria. Ms. Muttonen will serve as President for a term of one year.
